

Sharing Responsibilities for Kindergarten January Number Corner

<p>1. Sheets of 12" x 18" construction paper in the Yearlong Paper Chain colors cut into 1" x 7" strips for each classroom. You'll need about 10 in each color for each classroom. (You can get 28 strips out of a single, intact, piece of construction paper.) (See p. 142 for details.)</p>		
<p>2. Paper Chain Number Labels in 10, 20, 30, 40, 50, 60, 70, and 80 for each classroom. (You might want to make the labels for the entire year right now if it will be more efficient for you.) (See p. 142 for details.)</p>		
<p>3. Cut a brightly colored 5" x 5" piece of paper for each classroom. (This is not necessary if you still have these pieces of paper from prior months of Calendar Grid.) (See p. 144 for details.)</p>		
<p>4. Run 11–22 copies of Blacklines NC 19 and NC 20, January Calendar Markers, for each classroom on white paper or cardstock and cut apart. (See p. 145 for details.)</p>		
<p>5. Find a book or books with large pictures of a seal, shark, and whale for each classroom (or to share if your schedules will allow you to do this activity at different times). (See p. 145 for details.)</p>		
<p>6. Cut thirty-one 5" x 5" construction paper squares— 10 each of two different colors and 11 of the third color—for each classroom. (See p. 145 for details.)</p>		
<p>7. Run 1 copy of Blacklines NC 2 and NC 3 for each classroom and cut apart. (See p. 147 for details.)</p>		
<p>8. Use pages PA.20–PA.25 and PA.26–PA.29 of the Poems & Songs Portfolio to make two wall charts or two big books for each classroom. (See pp. 147 and 154 for details.)</p>
