

Sharing Responsibilities for Kindergarten March Number Corner

Task	Team Member	Date Due to Others
1. Cut sheets of 12" x 18" construction paper in the Yearlong Paper Chain colors into 1" x 7" strips for each classroom. You'll need about 10 in each color for each classroom. (You can get 28 strips out of a single, intact, piece of construction paper.) (See p. 213 for details.)		
2. Paper Chain Number Labels in 100 and 100 for each classroom, unless you already have a year's worth of labels. (See p. 213 for details.)		
3. Cut a brightly colored 5" x 5" piece of paper for each classroom. (This is not necessary if you still have these pieces of paper from prior months of Calendar Grid.) (See p. 215 for details.)		
4. Cut the following pieces of construction paper for each classroom to make the calendar markers: green: 20–30 6"-by-8" rectangles brown: 20–30 6"-by-8" rectangles white: two 2"-by-2" squares for each student black: two 2"-by-2" squares for each student (See p. 216 for details.)		
5. Run 1 copy of Blacklines NC 2 and NC 3 for each classroom and cut apart. (See p.218 for details.)		
6. Run 1 copy of Blackline NC 21 on cardstock for each classroom. (See p. 218 for details.)		
7. Run 8 copies of Blackline NC 22 on cardstock for each classroom, cut out the cards, and store in an envelope for each classroom. (See p. 221 for details.)		
8. Run 1 copy of Blacklines NC 23 and 24 for each classroom. (See p. 226 for details.) Run 1 copy of Blackline NC 29 on cardstock for each classroom, laminate, and attach clock hands. (See p. 234 for details.)
