A bit less than a class set of the following pieces of construction paper for each classroom to make spider and ladybug calendar markers:  red: 3" x 3"  black: 2" x 3" and 2" x 2"  brown: 3" x 3" and 2" x 2"</p> <p>Also cut plenty of ¼" x 3" strips of black and brown construction paper for legs and antennae. (See p. 58 for details.)</p>		
<p>3. Run 1 copy of Blacklines NC 2–4 for each classroom. (See pp. 61 and 71 for details.)</p>		
<p>4. Class set of 3" x 3" construction paper squares in any color for each classroom. (See p. 65 for details.)</p>		
<p>5. ¾" adhesive dots in several colors (Optional, See p. 71 for details.)</p>
